Life, Senior Active, and Junior Active Members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/ discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. . A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, trainer, handler, longeur or coach at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20.00 registration fee plus a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members and 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory Level Tests, Pas de Deux and Quadrille Classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. Also exempted from this requirement are residents of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own national Federation; 8) USEA Beginner Novice division, and 9) Assistant Handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding Classes.

I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless USDF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage arising from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities. I also hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless the show management, show committee and members, officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all loss, liability or damage from or because of, or in connection with, participation in this competition or related activities.

U.S. Equestrian Federation Entry Agreement

I have read the US EQUESTRIAN FED. ("the Federation") Entry Agreement (Rule GR1502.4) as printed in this Omnibus Prize List for all Prize Listed Competitions and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the use of my photos at the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State.

U.S. Equestrian Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification
This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition, named in front of this entry form which may be recognized either by USA Equestrian or by U.S. Equestrian both of which are included in the term "Federation" as used herein, to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (Harm).

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR318 and EV113, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the "the Federation" and "Competition" strongly encourages me that I do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.
